REGULATIONS 2025 EAST ASIAN WEIGHTLIFTING CHAMPIONSHIPS & CHINA-JAPAN-KOREA INTERNATIONAL WEIGHTLIFTING TOURNAMENT FUZHOU, CHINA

1. Dates & Place

30 July - 1 August 2025, Fuzhou, China

2. Competition & Training Venue

Fujian Majiang Weightlifting Center (No.66, Denglong Road, Mawei District, Fuzhou City, Fujian Province, China)

3. Accommodation

4. Financial Conditions-Accommodation & Fees

- Single Room: 100 USD per person per day with three meals
- Double Room: 80 USD per person per day with three meals
- Entry Fee: 120 USD per person

All accommodation charges & fees shall be paid to the Organizing Committee by bank transfer or upon arrival of each delegation at Fujian Majiang Weightlifting Center.

A minimum of 50% of the total payment must be transferred by 30 June 2025 to the bank account of the Organizing Committee.

5. Entries & Forms

Preliminary Entry

Member Federation must submit the Preliminary Entry of maximum numbers of sixteen (16) men & sixteen (16) women athletes by no later than 30 June 2025.

For Verification of Final Entry, only eight (8) men and eight (8) women athletes will be accepted, with a maximum of 2 athletes per bodyweight categories.

Final Entry

Member Federation must submit the Final Entry of maximum numbers of ten (10) men & ten (10) women athletes by no later than 15 July 2025. Only athlete(s) from the Preliminary Entry Form can be included into the Final Entry Form.

The following forms & documents must be returned before below deadlines.

Accommodation-transportation Form By 30 June 2025
Copies of all Passports & Photos By 20 June 2025
Visa Application Form By 20 June 2025

6. Visa

All participants must obtain visa to enter China at Chinese Embassy of respective countries with passports and necessary documents, except for citizens of visa exemption countries.







7. Accreditation

The Accreditation will take place at Fujian Majiang Weightlifting Center upon arrival.

8. Flag & Anthem

Each Member Federation should bring two (2) national/regional flags sized 100 X 150cm and national/regional anthems in USB drive.

9. Transportation

The Organizing Committee will provide the transportation from Fuzhou Changle International Airport to Fujian Majiang Weightlifting Center, and the participants must inform us of an accurate arrival & departure schedule by Transportation Form.

10. Competition Regulation

The 2025 East Asian Weightlifting Championships will follow the latest IWF Technical and Competition Rules & Regulations (IWF TCRR).

11. Terms and Conditions of Participation

Only Member Federations/Associations affiliated in the IWF/AWF are eligible to participate in the event. Accredited Participants – athletes, team officials, technical officials (ITO), media, guests, etc. must:

- Acknowledge and fully comply with IWF Constitution and By-Laws, TCRR, Anti- Doping Rules (ADR);
- Abide by all reasonable directions given by the IWF/AWF, LOC, TOs;
- Should accept any prize or award given by IWF/AWF and /or LOC/sponsors, and will attend all special award ceremonies where prizes or awards are presented;
- Should attend Press Conference upon request of IWF/AWF/LOC;
- · Should not participate in, support, or promote illegal betting;
- Should be responsible for all property they bring into the Event the IWF/AWF and/ or LOC shall have no responsibility in any loss or damage of the property;
- Should irrevocable release IWF/AWF & LOC from liability for any loss, injury, or damage that they may suffer in relation to their participation in the Event;
- Should guarantee that they participate in the Event with the permission
 of their parent(s) or guardian(s) in case they are minors;







- Should acknowledge that by not following the above-mentioned terms and conditions, sanctions may be imposed;
- Agree that entry is subject to payment of all fees inclusive of entry, anti-doping, accommodation, food and transportation payment prior to use of any LOC or IWF/AWF facility, or for airport transfers;
- Should acknowledge that no accommodation or arrangement is guaranteed until full payment is received in advance;
- All participating Federations/Associations should undertake full moral and financial responsibility of their registered/accredited delegates with regard to their health and wellness, and in the case of accidents or damages not attributable to the LOC.

12. Eligibility

Participating athletes must be 15 years of age and over (year of birth shall be 2010 or earlier).

13. Bodyweight Categories

Men: 60kg, 65kg, 71kg, 79kg, 88kg, 94kg, 110kg, +110kg Women: 48kg, 53kg, 58kg, 63kg, 69kg, 77kg, 86kg, +86kg

14. Awards

Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded in Snatch, Clean & Jerk, and Total in each bodyweight category.

Team trophies will be awarded to the best six teams respectively for both Men's and Women's competitions in accordance with IWF Team Classification.

Trophies will be awarded to the Best Lifter in the Men's and Women's events.

There will be different awards (in total only) for the 2025 International Weightlifting Tournament.

15. Technical Officials

Each Member Federation should nominate two technical officials (ideally one male and one female) from IWF licensed Technical Officials. No accommodation fee and Entry Fee is required for ITOs (up to 2 ITOs per Member Federation).

16. Barbells

IWF official / certified barbells or the products manufactured by a barbell supplier of the host nation will be used during the competition and training.







17. Insurance

According to IWF Regulations, all participants must be under coverage for travel and accident/injury insurance by their respective Federations/Associations before their departure from their nation/region.

18. Temperature & Electricity

The average temperature during the Championships will be approximately between 30 and 38 degrees on Celsius in Fuzhou, China. Electricity in China is 220 Vol-50 Hz.

19. 2025 International Weightlifting Tournament (China, Japan & Korea)

The Organizing Committee may offer 8 officials (including 2 International Technical Officials, ideally one male and one female) and 16 athletes (8 men and 8 women athletes) per Member Federation with free accommodation and meals during the official period of event.
